

Present Simple - "I do." vs. Present Continuous - "I am doing."

"What do you do?" = What is your job?

VS.

"What are you doing?" = What are you actually doing right now?

Q- "What does Mr. Bean do?"

A- "He's a teacher."

Q- "Is he sitting?"

A- "Yes, he **is sitting**, he's not standing.

Q- "What does he teach?"

A- "He teaches English."

Q- "What is he doing?"

A- "He's holding an apple."

Q- "Where does he work?"

A- "He works at a middle school in town."

Q- "Is he working there today?"

A- "No, he isn't working there today, it's closed."

Q- "What is he doing today?"

A- "He's driving to the store."

Q- "Does he often drive to the store?"

A- "No, he usually takes the bus."
