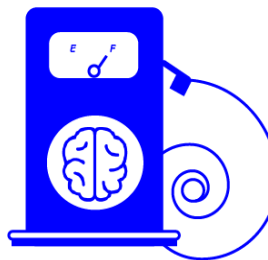

Brain Fueled

Present Simple - "I do." vs. Present Continuous - "I am doing."

"What do you do?" = What is your job?

vs.

"What are you doing?" = What are you actually doing right now?

Q- "What **does** Mr. Bean do?"

A- "He's a teacher."



Q- "Is he **sitting**?"

A- "Yes, he **is sitting**, he's not standing."

Q- "What **does** he teach?"

A- "He **teaches** English."



Q- "What **is** he **doing**?"

A- "He's **holding** an apple."



Q- "Where **does** he work?"

A- "He **works** at a middle school in town."



Q- "Is he **working** there today?"

A- "No, he **isn't working** there today, it's closed."

Q- "What **is** he **doing** today?"

A- "He's **driving** to the store."



Q- "**Does** he often **drive** to the store?"

A- "No, he **usually takes** the bus."
